



2026 OKLAHOMA'S PROMISE TEACHER ELIGIBILITY TRACK INCOME LIMITS

Effective July 1, 2025, House Bill 1727 expanded the Oklahoma's Promise scholarship program to help more families by creating a new teacher eligibility track through which children of Oklahoma public school teachers (with at least 10 years of certified service in the classroom) now qualify under a higher income limit. The household income must be under 700% of the federal poverty level (FPL). This level changes annually and is based on household size.

See the following tables for maximum annual and monthly household income limits by household size for the 2026 calendar year (subject to change annually).
