



WHO MAY APPLY

APPLICANTS MUST BE:

- Oklahoma residents.
- 8th-, 9th-, 10th- or 11th-grade students (homeschooled students must be age 13, 14, 15 or 16).
- Students who promise to meet the requirements of the program.

APPLICATION/AGREEMENT FORM

- Students whose parents' federal adjusted gross income for the most recent federal tax year does not exceed:
- \$60,000 with 1 or 2 dependent children OR
- \$70,000 with 3 or 4 dependent children OR
- \$80,000 with 5 or more dependent children (see Family Income Worksheet).

Special income provisions may apply to:

- Children adopted from certain court-ordered custody and children in the custody of court-appointed legal quardians.
- Social Security benefits based on the death or disability of the student's parent(s).

Additional documentation may be required.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED BY JULY 1, 2024

(homeschool applications must be postmarked before the student's 17th birthday)

THE PROMISE

The student promises to complete the program's high school and college requirements. If all the program requirements are met, the state of Oklahoma promises to help pay:

- Tuition at an Oklahoma public two-year college or four-year university.
- · A portion of tuition at an accredited Oklahoma private college or university.

• A portion of tuition for programs that qualify for federal financial aid at Oklahoma public career technology centers.

(The Oklahoma's Promise scholarship amount does not cover fees, books, supplies, or room and board.)

2023-24 APPLICATION/AGREEMENT FORM

A. HIGH SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS

THE STUDENT MUST:

- Graduate from high school and complete all high school requirements by the time of graduation.
- Complete the 17-unit college prep core curriculum and achieve at least a 2.50 cumulative GPA for the 17-unit core curriculum.
 The curriculum must be strictly followed, and students should be aware that some courses that meet high school graduation requirements do not meet Oklahoma's Promise requirements.
- Achieve at least a 2.50 cumulative GPA for all coursework attempted in grades 9 through 12...

The student must also agree to:

- Attend school regularly and do homework.
- · Refrain from substance abuse.
- Refrain from criminal or delinquent acts.
- Have school work and school records reviewed by an appropriate school official.
- Provide information to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education or the State Board of Education, if requested.
- Be contacted by the OKPromise office with information relevant to my application or the program when contact information is provided on the application.
- Apply for other financial aid during the senior year of high school.
- Participate in program activities.

THE PARENT

The student's parent(s), custodial parent(s) or quardian(s) must:

- Sign the agreement and help the student comply with the program requirements.
- Talk with school or other program personnel when asked to do so.
- Provide information to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education or the State Board of Education, if requested.
- Agree to be contacted by the OKPromise office with information relevant to the student's application or the program when contact information is provided on the application.
- Help the student apply for admission to college and file applications for financial aid.

REQUIRED CORE CURRICULUM*

- **4 ENGLISH** (grammar, composition, literature; courses should include an integrated writing component)
- **3 LAB SCIENCE** (biology, chemistry, physics or any lab science certified by the school district; general science with or without a lab may not be used to meet this requirement)
- **3 MATHEMATICS** (from Algebra I, Algebra II, geometry, trigonometry, math analysis, precalculus, statistics and probability [must have completed geometry and Algebra II], calculus, Advanced Placement [AP] statistics)
- **3 HISTORY AND CITIZENSHIP SKILLS** (including 1 unit of American history and 2 additional units from the subjects of history, economics, geography, government, non-Western culture)

2 FOREIGN OR NON-ENGLISH LANGUAGE (two years of the same language)

COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY (two units in programming, hardware or business computer applications, such as word processing, databases, spreadsheets and graphics, will qualify; keyboarding or typing classes do NOT qualify)

(1 foreign language and 1 computer course will NOT meet this requirement)

1 ADDITIONAL COURSE from any of the subjects listed above or psychology, sociology or any concurrent liberal arts and science course at a state system institution

1 FINE ARTS (music, art, drama)

*Homeschool students and students graduating from a high school not accredited by the Oklahoma State Board of Education must also achieve a composite score of 22 or higher on the ACT test reported on an official test report issued by ACT (including superscores). ACT on-campus (residual) test scores do not qualify.

B. COLLEGE REQUIREMENTS

PRIOR TO RECEIVING ANY PROGRAM BENEFIT

in college, the federal adjusted gross income (AGI) of the student's parents may not exceed \$100,000. Each year in college, Oklahoma's Promise students will be required to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), which will be used to determine whether the federal adjusted gross AGI exceeds \$100,000. For any year the AGI exceeds \$100,000, the student will not be eligible to receive the program benefit.

The student also:

- · Must be an Oklahoma resident.
- Must be a U.S. citizen or lawfully present in the United States.
- Shall meet regular admission standards for first-time entering students at the college or university to which the student applies.
- Must start taking college courses within three years after graduating high school.*
- May not use the award for noncredit remedial courses.
- May not receive funds for more than five consecutive years after enrolling in college.*
- May not use the award for courses taken after completion of the requirements for a bachelor's degree.
- May not receive award payments for more than 129 semester credit hours unless the student's degree program requires more than 129 hours.
- Must meet the college's Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy requirements for eligibility to receive federal financial aid.
- Will lose the scholarship permanently if suspended from college for more than one semester for conduct reasons.

^{*}Limited exemptions exist for students on active military duty.
