2001-2002 HIGHLIGHTS

- -- First OHLAP Students Earn College Degrees at a High Rate: Over half (54%) of the OHLAP scholarship recipients from the high school class of 1996 have earned college degrees. This is nearly 20% above the 35% degree-completion rate for all first-time, full-time freshmen college students.
- -- **2002 OHLAP High School Grads Set New Completion Record**: Over 67% of the students enrolled in OHLAP from the 2002 high school graduating class completed the program requirements to become eligible for the OHLAP scholarship. That's an increase of nearly 6% from the 61% completion rate of the 2001 class.
- -- **Significant Enrollment Increases Continue**: Nearly 7,000 students from 2001-02 high school sophomore class (Class of 2004) are enrolled in OHLAP; an increase of 18% over the enrollment of the class of 2003.
- -- Scholarship Costs Rising Dramatically: Expenditures for the OHLAP scholarships rose to nearly \$3 million in 2001-02, an increase of 26% from 2000-01. Based on current enrollment trends, scholarship costs are expected to grow dramatically every year.






II. Program Completion Rates:



III. High School Grade Point Average (GPA):




IV. ACT Scores:




V. **High School to College Going Rate:** (OHLAP high school graduates enrolling in college the year immediately following high school graduation)




VI. **Remediation Rates:** (OHLAP freshmen scholarship recipients requiring at least one remedial course as a percentage of all OHLAP freshmen students.)



VII. College Grade Point Average:





IX. Persistence to Second Year of College:




X. Six-year Degree Completion Rate (includes baccalaureate and associate degrees):





XI. Five-Year Degree Completion Rate (includes baccalaureate and associate degrees):




XII. Number of Scholarship Recipients:

"OHLAP-Plus" Scholarships

In August 1999, the Oklahoma State Regents were awarded a five-year \$20.5 million federal grant through a new program named GEAR UP (Gaining Early Awareness for Undergraduate Programs). The goal of the program is to increase the number of low-income students who complete college degrees. A significant portion of the grant funding was designated for direct scholarship expenses. To build upon the existing success of OHLAP, the scholarships were targeted at OHLAP students with the greatest financial need.

Amount of the Scholarship: In 2001-02, the GEAR UP funds allowed an eligible OHLAP student to receive an additional award that doubled the amount of their regular OHLAP scholarship (hence the name OHLAP-Plus). For example, an OHLAP student who received a \$1,500 regular OHLAP scholarship could receive another \$1,500 OHLAP-Plus scholarship from the GEAR UP grant [Example: \$1,500 OHLAP + \$1,500 OHLAP-Plus = \$3,000].

Student Eligibility Requirements: To receive the OHLAP-Plus award in 2001-02, the student had to meet the following criteria:

- -- Received a regular OHLAP award
- -- Received a federal Pell grant award (which is need-based)
- -- Had remaining unmet need within their defined "cost of attendance". For example, the OHLAP-Plus awards could substitute for student loans.

Highlights:

- -- Almost three-fourths (74%) of all OHLAP students received a Pell grant, but 6% of these received sufficient other aid to cover their cost of attendance and therefore were not eligible for the OHLAP-Plus scholarship.
- -- Over two-thirds (70%) of the OHLAP students received an OHLAP-Plus award—almost \$2.0 million was distributed to over 1,300 students.
- -- Pell-eligible OHLAP students attending higher cost institutions (comprehensive and regional public universities, private universities) were most likely to have unmet need and therefore also most likely to receive OHLAP-Plus scholarships. Nearly 100% of Pell-eligible OHLAP students at the public comprehensive universities and private universities received OHLAP-Plus; over 90% of those at public regional universities received the scholarship. Around 87% of Pell-eligible OHLAP students at public two-year colleges received OHLAP-Plus.
