

## Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program (OHLAP)

2002-2003 Year-End Report

#### **2002-2003 HIGHLIGHTS**

- -- **2003 OHLAP Class Grows Over 150%**: The number of OHLAP high school seniors qualifying for the scholarship in 2003 totaled nearly 4,200 students, an increase of 157% from the 1,622 OHLAP qualifiers in 2002.
- -- 2003 OHLAP High School Grads Set Another New Completion Record: Like each graduating class before them, the 2003 OHLAP seniors achieved a record-high level for completing the OHLAP requirements. Over 71% of the students in the 2003 OHLAP class successfully completed the program requirements to become eligible for the OHLAP scholarship. That's an increase of 4% from the 67% completion rate of the 2002 class.
- -- **High School Enrollments Continue to Increase**: Some 7,500 students from 2002-03 high school sophomore class (Class of 2005) are enrolled in OHLAP; an increase of 6.5% over the enrollment of the class of 2004.
- -- Scholarship Promises Kept; Future Costs Will Rise Dramatically: Every OHLAP scholarship earned in 2002-03 was paid in full as program expenditures rose to \$4.6 million, an increase of 57% from 2001-02. Based on current enrollment trends, scholarship costs will continue to grow significantly every year.

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





#### **II.** Program Requirement Completion Rates:



#### III. High School Grade Point Average (GPA):




#### IV. ACT Scores:




# V. **High School to College-Going Rate:** (OHLAP high school graduates enrolling in college the year immediately following high school graduation)




# VI. Remediation Rates: (OHLAP freshmen scholarship recipients requiring at least one remedial course as a percentage of all OHLAP freshmen students.)



#### VII. College Grade Point Average:





#### IX. Persistence Rate to Second Year of College:








#### **XI.** Number of Scholarship Recipients:

## "OHLAP-Plus" Scholarships

In August 1999, the Oklahoma State Regents were awarded a five-year \$20.5 million federal grant through a new program named GEAR UP (Gaining Early Awareness for Undergraduate Programs). The goal of the program is to increase the number of low-income students who complete college degrees. A significant portion of the grant funding was designated for direct scholarship expenses. To build upon the existing success of OHLAP, the scholarships were targeted at OHLAP students with the greatest financial need.

**Amount of the Scholarship:** In 2002-03, the GEAR UP funds allowed an eligible OHLAP student to receive an additional award that doubled the amount of their regular OHLAP scholarship (hence the name OHLAP-Plus). For example, an OHLAP student who received a \$1,500 regular OHLAP scholarship could receive another \$1,500 OHLAP-Plus scholarship from the GEAR UP grant [Example: \$1,500 OHLAP + \$1,500 OHLAP-Plus = \$3,000].

**2002-03 Student Eligibility Requirements:** The OHLAP-Plus eligibility criteria was modified in 2002-03 due to the dramatic increase in the number of OHLAP students. An additional limitation requiring students to have an EFC (Expected Family Contribution) of \$1,000 or less was implemented to ensure that available funds would be focused on students with the greatest financial need. To receive the OHLAP-Plus award in 2002-03, the student had to meet the following criteria:

- -- Received a regular OHLAP award
- -- Received a federal Pell grant award (which is need-based) with an EFC of \$1,000 or less
- -- Had remaining unmet need within their defined "cost of attendance". For example, the OHLAP-Plus awards could substitute for student loans.

The OHLAP-Plus award will be phased out, beginning in 2003-04. Only OHLAP participants graduating high school in 2002 and prior years will be eligible for the OHLAP-Plus scholarship. The remaining funds available for the award should be sufficient to continue paying the award to those OHLAP college students who had previously received the award.

#### **Highlights:**

- -- A little less than half (45%) of the OHLAP college students received an OHLAP-Plus award in 2002-03—\$2.0 million was distributed to over 1,200 students.
- -- OHLAP students attending higher cost institutions (comprehensive and regional public universities, private universities) were most likely to have unmet need and therefore also most likely to receive OHLAP-Plus scholarships. Approximately 46% of OHLAP students at the public comprehensive and regional universities received the award; the percentage at private universities was 56%. Around 36% of OHLAP students at public two-year colleges received OHLAP-Plus.
