2003-2004 HIGHLIGHTS

- **2004 OHLAP High School Class Tops 5,000:** The number of OHLAP high school seniors qualifying for the scholarship in 2004 totaled 5,019 students, an increase of 19% from the 4,211 OHLAP qualifiers in 2003.
- > OHLAP High School Completion Rate Dips Slightly: For the first time in the history of the program, the percentage of OHLAP students completing the high school requirements declined slightly from the previous year. The completion rate for 2004 OHLAP seniors was just under 70%, a decrease of 1.7% from 2003.
- > **High School Enrollments Keep Edging Up**: Nearly 8,000 students from 2003-04 high school sophomore class (high school graduating class of 2006) are enrolled in OHLAP; an increase of 4% over the enrollment of the class of 2005.
- > Scholarship Recipients Double in One Year; Costs Will Keep Rising: Nearly 6,000 OHLAP college students received the scholarship in 2003-04, almost twice the number of 2002-03. The costs of the scholarship more than doubled to \$10.4 million, up from \$4.6 million the previous year. Based on current enrollment trends, the projected scholarship costs will continue to grow significantly in each of the next few years.







II. Program Requirement Completion Rates:



III. High School Grade Point Average (GPA):






V. **High School to College-Going Rate:** (OHLAP high school graduates enrolling in college the year immediately following high school graduation)




VI. Remediation Rates: (OHLAP freshmen scholarship recipients requiring at least one remedial course as a percentage of all OHLAP freshmen students.)





IX. Persistence Rate to Second Year of College:








XI. Number of Scholarship Recipients:

"OHLAP-Plus" Scholarships

In August 1999, the Oklahoma State Regents were awarded a five-year \$20.5 million federal grant through a new program named GEAR UP (Gaining Early Awareness for Undergraduate Programs). The goal of the program is to increase the number of low-income students who complete college degrees. A significant portion of the grant funding has been designated for direct scholarship expenses. To build upon the existing success of OHLAP, the scholarships have been targeted at OHLAP students with the greatest financial need.

Amount of the Scholarship: In 2003-04, the GEAR UP funds allowed an eligible OHLAP student to receive an additional award that doubled the amount of their regular OHLAP scholarship (hence the name OHLAP-Plus). For example, an OHLAP student who received a \$1,500 regular OHLAP scholarship could receive another \$1,500 OHLAP-Plus scholarship from the GEAR UP grant [Example: \$1,500 OHLAP + \$1,500 OHLAP-Plus = \$3,000].

2003-04 Student Eligibility Requirements: The OHLAP-Plus eligibility criteria was modified in 2002-03 due to the dramatic increase in the number of OHLAP students. An additional limitation requiring students to have an EFC (Expected Family Contribution) of \$1,000 or less was implemented to ensure that available funds would be focused on students with the greatest financial need. This was carried over to the 2003-04 year. To receive the OHLAP-Plus award in 2003-04, the student had to meet the following criteria:

- > Received a regular OHLAP award
- > Received a federal Pell grant award (which is need-based) with an EFC of \$1,000 or less
- > Had remaining unmet need within their defined "cost of attendance". For example, the OHLAP-Plus awards could substitute for student loans.

Gear Up has been awarded additional funding for year six. The amount of scholarship dollars awarded is sufficient to continue the OHLAP-Plus award through the 2004-05 school year. The program will be phased out provided additional funding does not become available. Only OHLAP participants graduating high school in 2002 and prior years will be eligible for the OHLAP-Plus scholarship. The remaining funds available for the award should be sufficient to continue paying the award to those OHLAP college students who had previously received the award.

Highlights:

- > Less than 20% of the OHLAP college students received an OHLAP-Plus award in 2003-04—\$1.9 million was distributed to just over 1,200 students.
- > OHLAP students attending higher cost institutions (comprehensive and regional public universities, private universities) were most likely to have unmet need and therefore also most likely to receive OHLAP-Plus scholarships. Approximately 21% of OHLAP students at the public comprehensive and regional universities received the award; the percentage at private universities was 18%. Around 13% of OHLAP students at public two-year colleges received OHLAP-Plus.
