



# 2011-12 Year End Report

## HIGHLIGHTS:

- In 2011-12, for the first time in the history of the program, the number of Oklahoma's Promise award recipients in college declined slightly from the previous year, from 20,081 in 2010-11 to 20,029 in 2011-12.
- The number of award recipients is projected to decline further over the next two years as shown below. The decline is due to several factors, including implementation of legislative changes requiring a second family income check at the time the student starts college, the application of federal satisfactory academic progress standards, and new statutory college GPA requirements.




## OKPromise High School Enrollment

(By High School Graduation Year)





## High School Requirement Completion Rates





## Geographic Distribution Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2004-2012





## Gender Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2002-2012







## Ethnicity – 2012 HS Completers




## 2012 ACT Testers By Income\*





## 2012 Average ACT Scores By Income\*





## 2012 ACT Composite Scores





## College-Going Rates Compared to All Oklahoma HS Graduates





(OKPromise freshmen scholarship recipients requiring at least one remedial course as a percentage of all OKPromise freshmen students.)


## College Freshman – GPA of at least 2.0





## College Freshman to Sophomore Persistence Rates




## Full-Time College Enrollment



First-time entering students enrolled in 12 hours or more per fall or spring semester


## Degree Completion Rates

(Degrees earned through 2011-12)




## OKPromise Graduates Employment

(Employed in Oklahoma between April 2010 and June 2011)




## Scholarship Recipients


## Scholarship Expenditures
