



2016-17 Year End Report

HIGHLIGHTS:

- The percentage of Oklahoma's Promise students completing the program's high school requirements increased in 2017 to 71.5%, the highest level in fourteen years. The completion rate has increased in each of the last five years.
- The 2017 Oklahoma Legislature approved the most significant changes in the program in the past decade. Those changes include:
 - Increasing the family income limit at the time of application from \$50,000 to \$55,000 beginning in the 2017-2018 academic year. The law schedules another increase to \$60,000 beginning in 2021-2022.
 - Prohibiting awards for zero-level remedial courses beginning in 2018-2019.
 - Aligning scholarship academic retention requirements with institutional degree-completion standards (satisfactory academic progress or SAP standards).
 - Capping the number of semester credit hours for which the award will pay, beginning with 2018-2019 college freshmen students. The proposed limit is 129 semester credit hours with exceptions for degrees requiring more hours.
 - Authorizing the award to be used for more career-technology programs.
 - Checking the second income limit of \$100,000 every year the student is enrolled in college, beginning in 2018-2019.





Estimated Percent of Oklahoma Families with Total Income Under \$50,000





OKPromise High School Enrollment (By High School Graduation Year)





High School Requirement Completion Rates (by grad year)





High School Students Completing OKPromise Requirements (by Grad Year)





Geographic Distribution Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2009-2017




Gender Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2007-2017




Ethnicity – 2017 HS Completers




High School GPA's



2017 ACT Composite Scores








College Remediation Rates




College Freshman – GPA of at least 2.0





Full-Time College Enrollment




First-time entering students enrolled full-time in fall or spring semester




Degree Completion Rates

(Degrees earned through 2016-17)




Employment of OKPromise Graduates

(Employed in Oklahoma between April 2015 and June 2016)







Where Do Oklahoma's Promise Students Attend College?



Average Annual Scholarship by Tier




Scholarship Recipients
