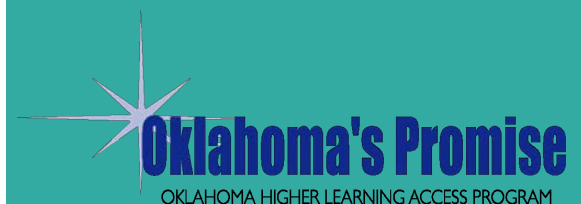


Oklahoma's Promise 2023-24 Year-End Report

February 6, 2025

Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education



Highlights

- Oklahoma’s Promise continues to impact high school students’ interest in and access to Oklahoma higher education. In 2024, 79% of Oklahoma’s Promise public school students attended an Oklahoma college or university, as compared to 35% of their non-Oklahoma’s Promise public school peers.
- In 2023-2024, enrollment in the program grew significantly, with nearly 15,000 scholarship recipients and \$68.1 million in expenditures, marking the first increase in several years.
- In 2023-24, current and former Oklahoma’s Promise scholarship recipients earned a total of 4,205 certificates and degrees ranging from undergraduate certificates to doctoral and professional degrees. Over half of the degrees awarded were bachelor degrees (52%) and almost a third (31%) were associate degrees. Another 12% were advanced degrees.
- Oklahoma’s Promise graduates continue to have one of the highest Oklahoma employment rates of any student population in the state. In total, more than 94% of Oklahoma’s Promise graduates were employed in Oklahoma one year after graduation, and 86% were employed in Oklahoma five years after graduation.

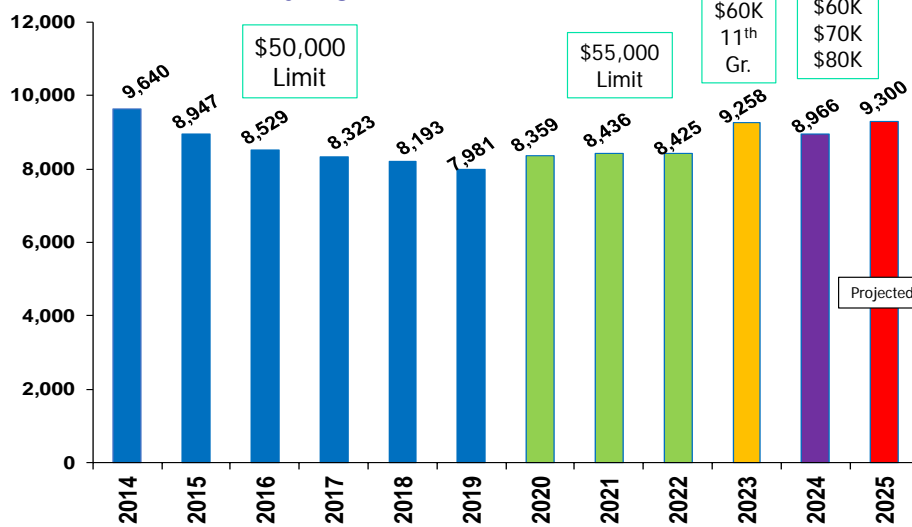
The enrollment for 2025 may increase as some pending incomplete applications are processed.

OKPromise High School Enrollment

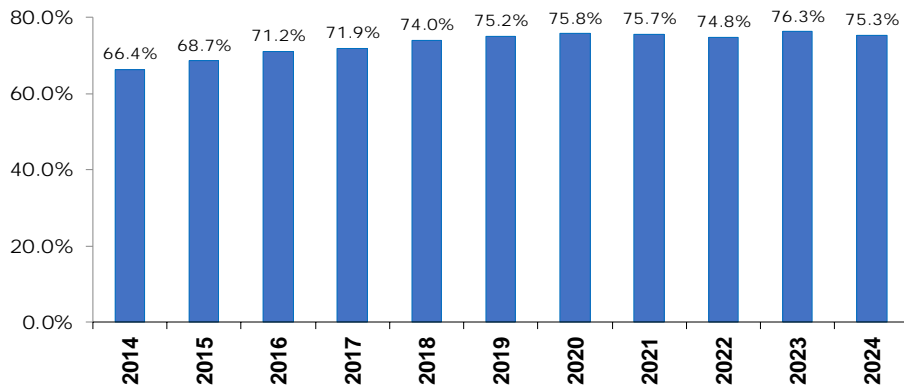
(By High School Graduation Year)

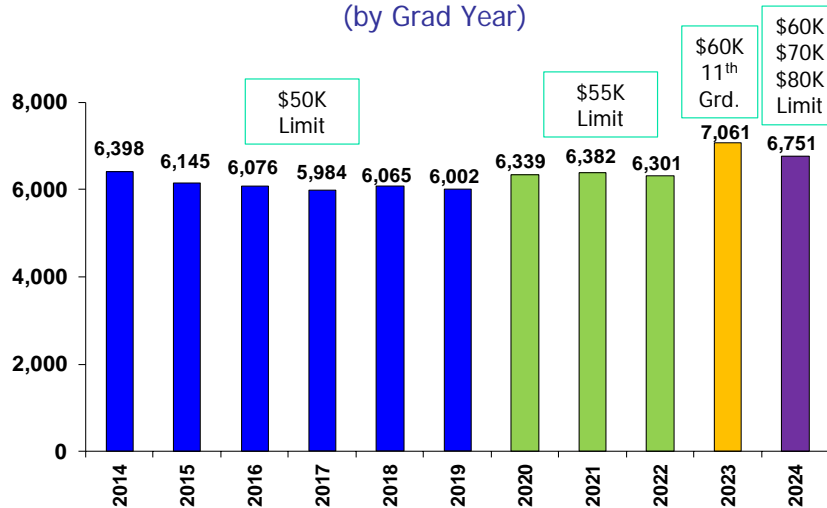
Percentage of High School Students Completing OKPromise Requirements (by Grad Year)

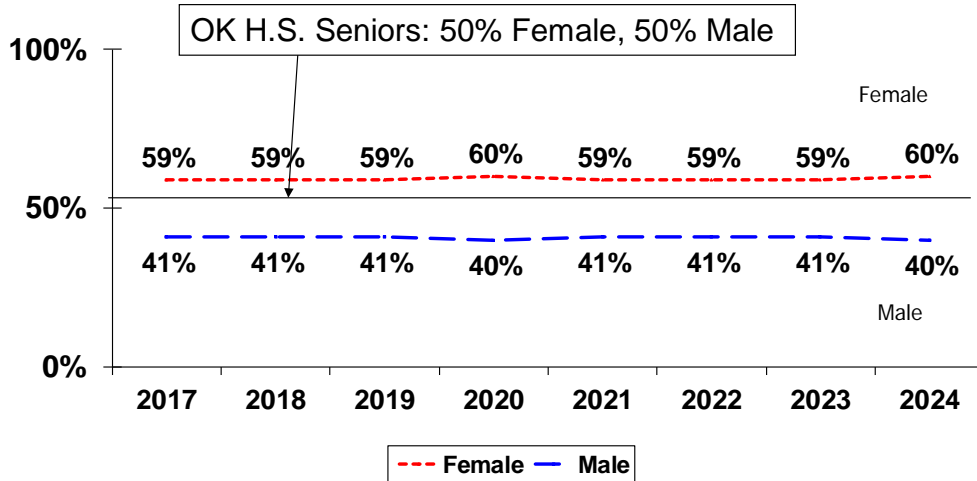


High School Students Completing OKPromise Requirements (by Grad Year)

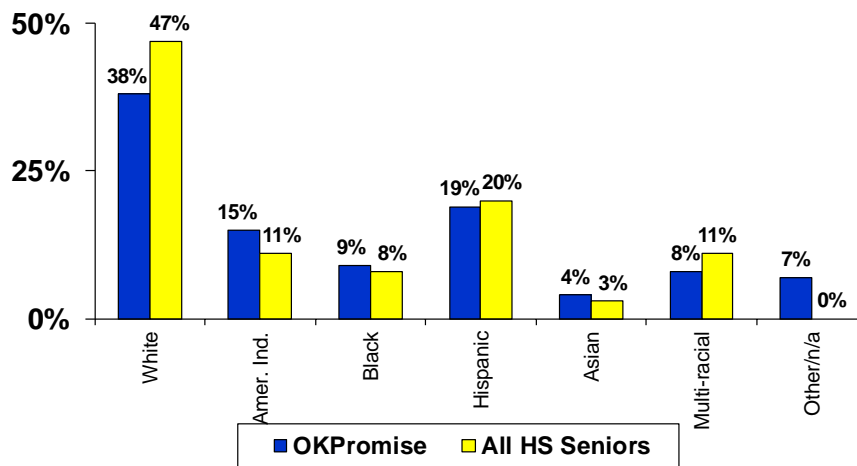

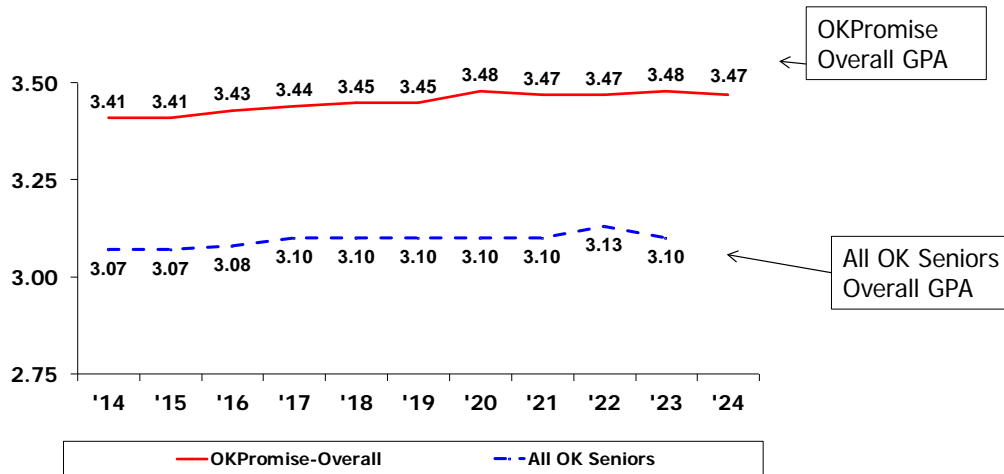
Gender Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2017-2024



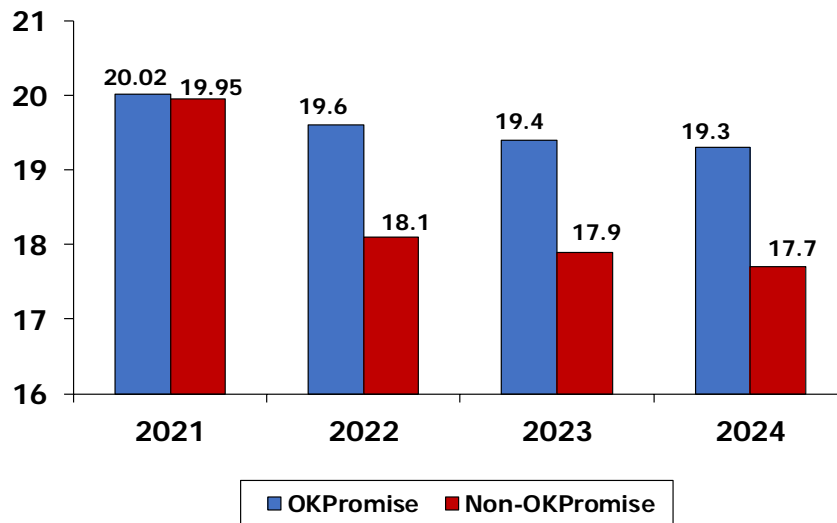
Ethnicity – 2024 HS Completers



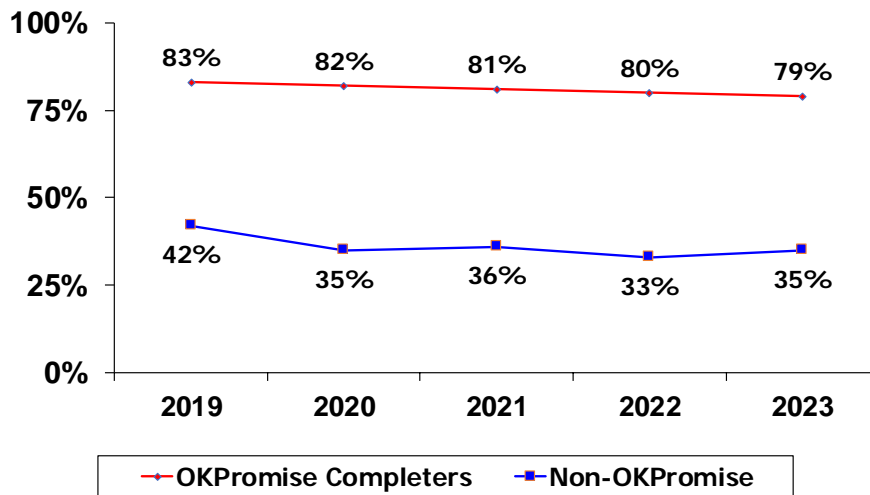
High School GPA



ACT Scores, 2020-2024

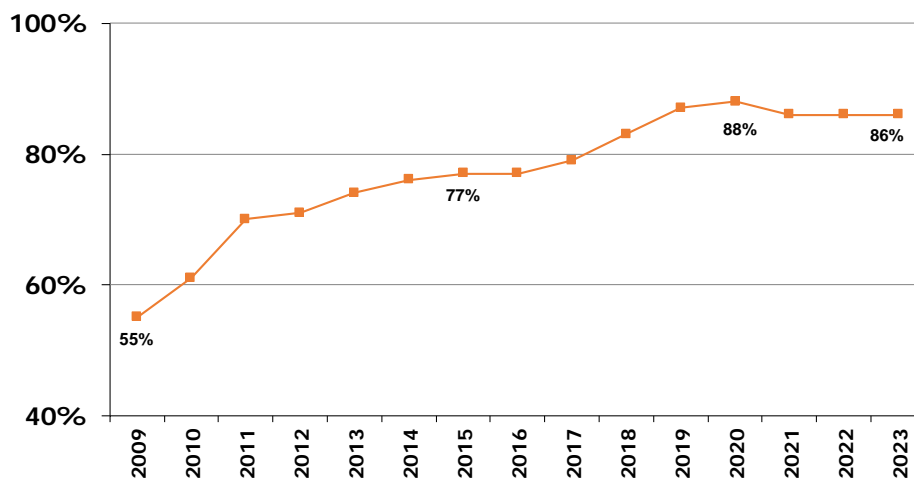

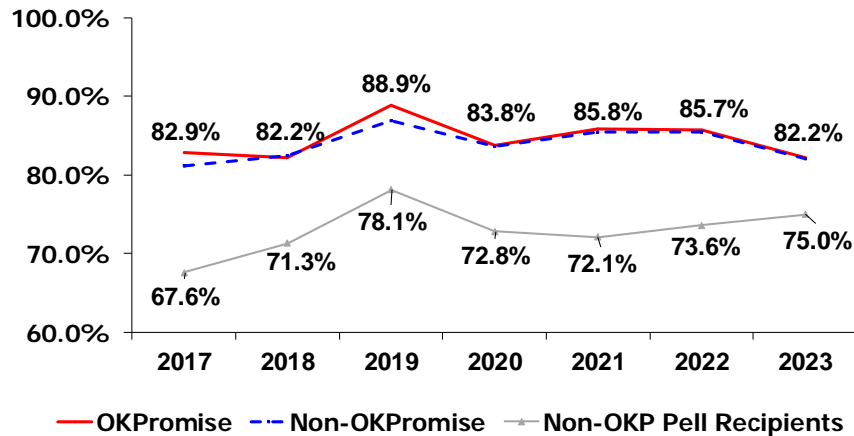

Percent of OKPromise Recipients Eligible for Federal Pell Grants

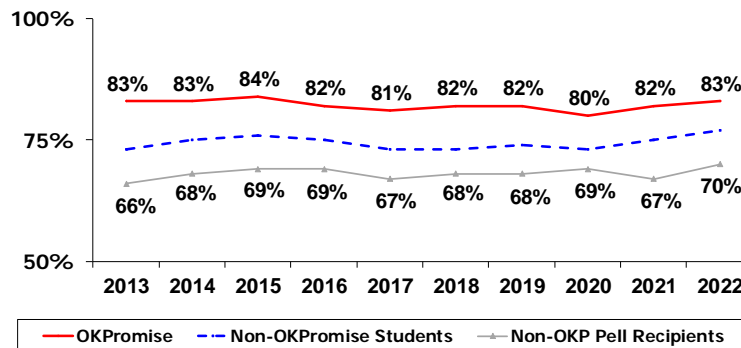


College Freshmen – GPA of at least 2.0

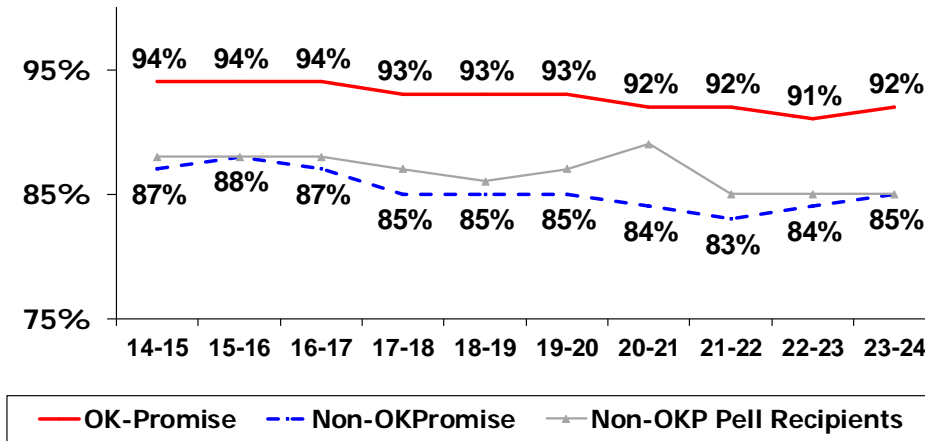

College Freshman to Sophomore Persistence Rates



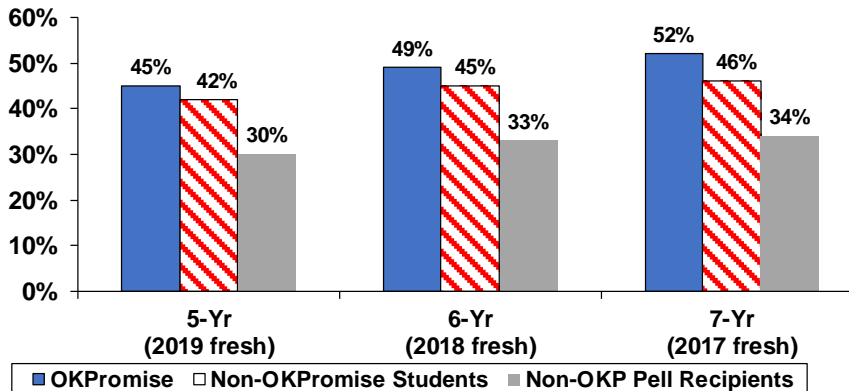
Full-Time College Enrollment

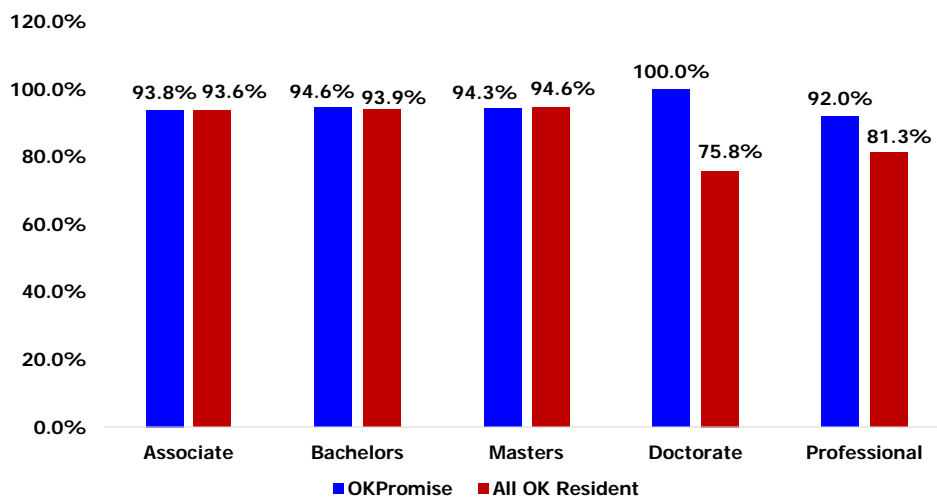

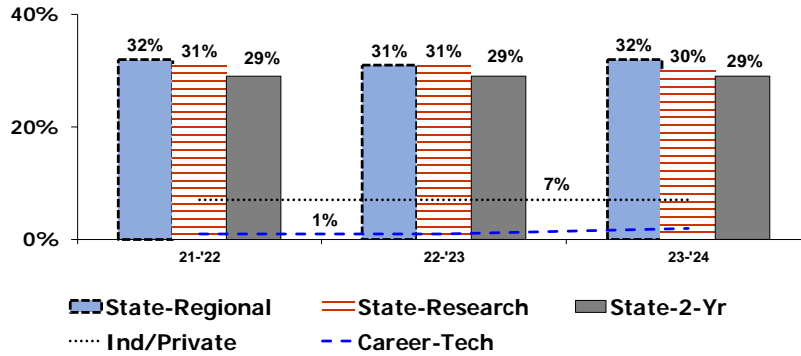

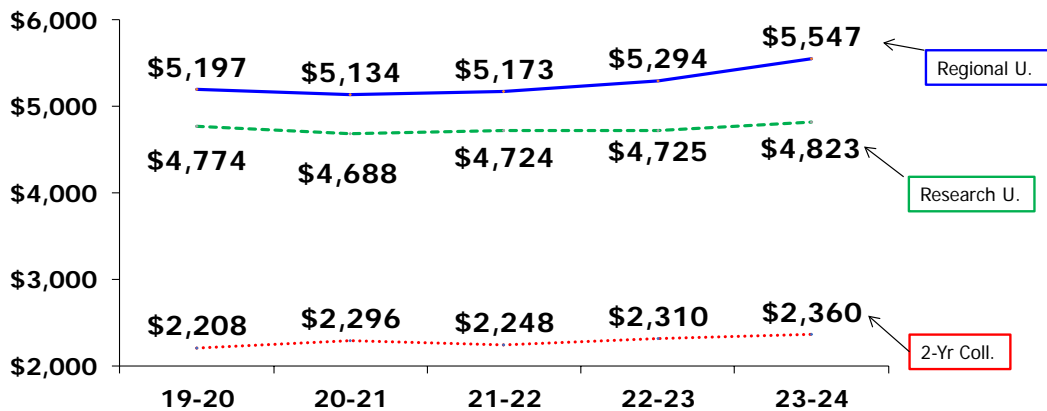
Employment of Graduates in Oklahoma One Year after Graduation



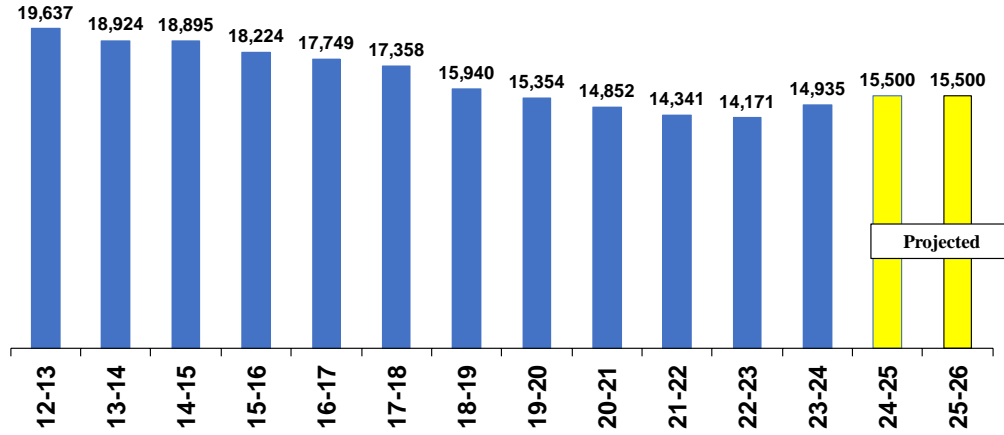
Where Do Oklahoma's Promise Students Attend College?



Average Annual Scholarship by Tier



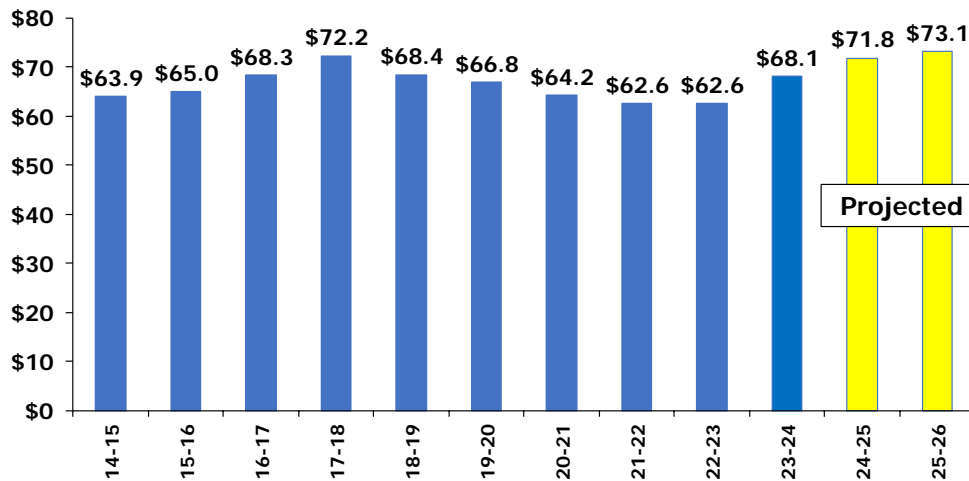
Scholarship Recipients
